**SECTION 3 TRAINING PROGRAM / PART-TIME GENERAL LABORER**

**Purpose of Section 3:**

The purpose of section 3 of the Housing and Urban Development Act of 1968 (12 U.S.C. 1701u) (Section 3) is to ensure that employment and other economic opportunities generated by certain HUD financial assistance shall, to the greatest extent feasible, and consistent with existing Federal, State and local laws and regulations, be directed to low- and very low-income persons, particularly those who are recipients of government assistance for housing, and to business concerns which provide economic opportunities to low- and very low-income persons.

**Who are Section 3 Residents?**

Section 3 residents are public housing residents and low and very-low income persons who live in the Hartford metropolitan area or non-metropolitan County (to view your local income limits click <http://www.huduser.org/portal/datasets/il/il2015/2015summary.odn> where HUD assisted project for housing or community development is located).

**To qualify you must have/submit the following:**

- Be at least 18 years of age
- High school diploma/GED
- Be physically capable of performing the essential functions of the training program, with or without reasonable accommodation, and without posing a direct threat to the health and safety of the individual or others.
- Must have or will have, within six (6) months, a valid Connecticut Driver's License.
- Will be required to submit to: 1) screening for current illegal use of drugs; 2) background screening, both as a condition of accepting into the program and prior to being employed

This is a part-time Section 3 General Laborers training program. The hours will be 28 per week at \$15.00 per hour with no benefits.
